10. Implementation & Monitoring

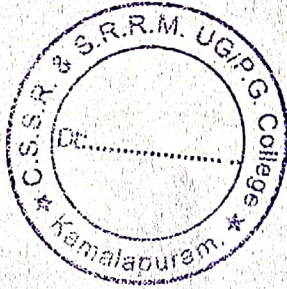
- The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) shall oversee implementation
